

ServiceNow Micro-Certification – ServiceNow Platform Subscription Model Exam Specification

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Introduction

The ServiceNow Platform Subscription Model Micro Certification Exam Specification defines the purpose, audience, testing options, exam content coverage, test framework, and prerequisites to become ServiceNow Platform Subscription Model certified.

Exam Purpose

The ServiceNow Platform Subscription Model exam certifies that a successful candidate understands how the subscription model works and what the implications are when developing and extending applications in the Now Platform®.

Exam Audience

The ServiceNow Platform Subscription Model exam is available to ServiceNow customers, partners, and employees.

Exam Preparation

Exam questions are based on official ServiceNow training materials, the ServiceNow documentation site, and the ServiceNow developer site. Study materials posted elsewhere online are not official and should not be used to prepare for the examination.

Prerequisite ServiceNow Training Path

ServiceNow requires the completion of the following prerequisite training course(s) in preparation for the ServiceNow Platform Subscription Model Micro Certification exam. Information provided in the following ServiceNow training course(s) contain source material for the exam.

- ServiceNow Platform Subscription Model - *Upon completion, the candidate will be issued a voucher code to register for the ServiceNow Platform Subscription Model Micro Certification exam.

Additional Recommended Experience

- Six (6) months field experience participating in ServiceNow deployment projects or maintaining ServiceNow instances.
- General familiarity with industry terminology, acronyms, and initialisms

Exam Registration

Each candidate must register for the exam via the ServiceNow [Webassessor](#) website using a voucher obtained by completing the ServiceNow Platform Subscription Model training prerequisite. The exam is available directly through the Webassessor site as a non-proctored, 60-minute exam.

Exam Structure

The exam consists of {15-25} questions. For each question on the examination, there are multiple possible responses. The person taking the exam reviews the response options and selects the *most correct* answer to the question.

Multiple Choice (single answer)

For each multiple-choice question on the exam, there are four possible responses. The candidate taking the exam reviews the response options and selects the one response most accurately answers the question.

Multiple Select (select all that apply)

For each multiple-select question on the exam, there are at least four possible responses. The question will state how many responses should be selected. The candidate taking the exam reviews the response options and selects ALL responses that accurately answer the question. Multiple-select questions have two or more correct responses.

Exam Results

After completing and submitting the exam, a pass or fail result is immediately calculated and displayed to the candidate. More detailed results are not provided to the candidate.

Exam Retakes

If a candidate fails to pass an exam, they may register to take the exam again up to three more times for a cost of \$25.

Sample Question(s)

Sample Item #1:

What determines the subscription model that is applicable when a new custom table is created?

- A. A custom table that is created in a sub-production environment it cannot be determined what subscription models applies. Once the custom table is moved to the production environment it is unassigned by default and therefore considered part of the App Engine, the table has to be manually assigned to a subscription bundle for a different subscription model to apply.
- B. When a custom table is created, whether this occurs in the production or a sub-production environment, at the point of creation the user creating the table selects what subscription model will apply to the table.
- C. A new custom table that is created is automatically linked to the primary subscription of the customer. This subscription model is the default model that applies until the custom table gets re-assigned.

Answer: A
